

## Pick-up Counter Service for Purchases from a Duty Free Shop in Central Tokyo


On January 28, 2016 (Thurs), TIAT will launch a pick-up counter service for goods that are purchased at an airport-style duty free shop in central Tokyo.

The launch of this service coincides with the opening of the Japan Duty Free GINZA shop inside the Ginza Mitsukoshi Department Store. Customers who are departing from the Haneda Airport International Passenger Terminal can purchase duty free goods at this shop and pick up those purchases at the terminal on the day of their flight.

This service offers a new duty free shopping experience and will now enable both visitors who are returning to their home countries as well as Japanese travelers who are heading abroad to enjoy much greater flexibility when purchasing duty free goods.

- Service Launch Date
  January 28, 2016 (Thu), from 4:00 am (The counter will be open 24 hours a day.)
- Pick-up Counter Location

The pick-up counter is located in the departures area on the 3rd floor of the Haneda Airport International Passenger Terminal (in the area after passing through Passport Control).



- Points to Note when Using this Service
  - ① Pick-up times for purchases may vary depending on the flight and the point of purchase. Customers should confirm the pick-up time before purchasing their duty free goods.
  - ② Customers must present their passport, boarding pass, and Record of Purchase of Consumption Tax-Exempt for Export in order to pick up their purchases.
