# Secom Wearable Cameras as Standard Issue at Haneda Airport's International Terminal

## Decision Taken after Trial Introduction

SECOM CO., LTD. (Head Office: Shibuya, Tokyo; President & Representative Director: Yasuo Nakayama) and Tokyo International Air Terminal Corporation (Head Office: Ota, Tokyo; President & CEO: Katsuji Doi) have announced that, following proving trials for Secom wearable cameras used by roving security personnel at Haneda Airport which commenced in April this year and the success of those trials, the Secom wearable camera will be used as standard issue.

With the continuing trends towards internationalization in response to Japan's ongoing development as a tourism destination, more sophisticated security with greater mobility is now important to protect against terrorism at Haneda Airport, which services as the portal to Japan's skies.

With the introduction of these cameras in day to day operations the following results are anticipated.

(1) Roving security personnel will patrol around the terminal and in the lobbies wearing the cameras on their chests. This will provide coverage in dead areas where surveillance cameras cannot reach and will, therefore, increase security.

(2) If a security incident does occur, the video images will be transmitted to the monitors in the Disaster Prevention Center in real time. The Disaster Prevention Center will be immediately able to assess the situation based on the verbal reports given by the guards on site via mobile telephone or radio transmission as well as the video images. This will enable the center to understand the situation instantly and respond quickly and efficiently not only to security incidents but also to facility management issues.

(3) Video images transmitted from the wearable cameras are stored safely in Secom's secure data center, which boasts solid security, and can be viewed whenever necessary.

The safety and reliability of an airport based on a high level of security is the foundation of key transport infrastructure. Secom Co., Ltd. and Tokyo International Air Terminal Corporation will continue to collaborate in an effort to improve technology and services to remain compatible with a range of security requirements, and also to improve the safety of the International Passenger Terminal at Haneda Airport, the gateway to Japan's skies.
