

Passenger Service Facilities Charge (PSFC) Amended Due to Increase in Consumption Tax Rate

We wish to advise that, effective 1 October 2019, the Passenger Service Facilities Charge at the International Terminal at Tokyo International Airport (Haneda Airport) is to be amended to accommodate an increase in Japan's consumption tax rate.

1. Amended PSFC Charge

(1) PSFC charge per departing passenger (including consumption tax)

Category	<u>Amended Charge</u>	Current Charge
Adult (ages 12 and up)	2,610 yen	2,570 yen
Child (ages 2 to 11)	1,300 yen	1,280 yen

Infants under two years of age flying on a child's ticket will be subject to the charge for children.

(2) PSFC charge per transit passenger (including consumption tax)

Category	<u>Amended Charge</u>	Current Charge
Adult (ages 12 and up)	1,300 yen	1,280 yen
Child (ages 2 to 11)	650 yen	640 yen

Infants under two years of age flying on a child's ticket will be subject to the charge for children.

2. Effective Date of Amended Charge

Tickets issued on or after 1 October 2019.

(Tickets issued prior to that date will be subject to the existing rate.)

3. Method of Payment

As before, the charge will be included in the air fare when the ticket is purchased.

(On-ticket payment.)

4. PSFC

Tokyo International Air Terminal Corporation collects the PSFC from passengers departing Japan.

This charge is used to supplement the cost of maintaining and operating the facilities and passenger information equipment in the common-use areas. We remain committed to customer satisfaction in our airport and ask for your continued cooperation.
