Tokyo International Airport Haneda Awarded First Place in Two Categories in Skytrax's World Airport Awards

At the World Airport Awards 2017 held by Skytrax¹ of the UK, this year, Haneda also moved up in the World's Best Airport ranking, an overall airport assessment, to second place from last year's forth place.

The domestic terminals at Tokyo International Airport Haneda were awarded first place in the World's Best Domestic Airport category for the fifth year in a row, and Haneda's domestic and international terminals² were presented with first place in the World's Best Airport Cleanest category for the second year in a row.

Haneda's domestic terminals impressed the judges in the World's Best Domestic Airport category for their ease of use and ease of access among other merits.

In the World's Best Airport Cleanliness category, Haneda's domestic and international terminals won awards for two consecutive years, and it was thanks to even greater efforts on the part of all employees working at Haneda that the terminals' cleanliness and comfort made a good impression once again, leading to this year's award.
